<u>FLEX</u> (<u>Future Leaders Exchange Program</u>) – High school students aged 14–17 spend a full school year at a U.S. high school and live with a host family.

• <u>Benjamin Franklin Transatlantic Fellowship</u> - Four-week summer exchange program in the United States for students aged 16-18. Participants will explore transatlantic relations, leadership development, critical thinking, diplomacy, community activism, and the media.

 Women2Women – 10-day leadership program in the United States each summer for girls aged 15-19.

 YTILI – The Young Transatlantic Innovation Leaders Initiative is for emerging entrepreneurs from Europe ages 25-35. As part of a year-long program, you will spend several weeks during the spring in the United States to develop your skills and network with your business counterparts.

<u>SUSI (Study of the U.S. Institutes)</u> – This six-week summer program in the United States is for students interested in civic engagement. Through academic sessions, workshops and projects, participants will gain skills to become engaged citizens in their own communities.

• IREX CEE (Community Engagement Exchange) - CEE is a year-long transformational leadership development experience, which includes a three-month practicum in the United States, designed to enable civil society leaders, ages 21-28, to harness the power of networks, relationships, and much more.


